2.2.1 PREAMBLE

- ❖ The Institution employs several methods and events to assess the students in terms of knowledge and skills before the commencement and during the conduction of the course. The members of the admission committee examine the ability and enquire the interest of the students in accordance with the branch selected by the students at the time of admission. Induction programmes and coaching sessions are conducted for the newly admitted students for assessing their knowledge and skills. Every Department also conducts orientation programme for newly admitted students with events to identify the outstanding students.
- ❖ The advanced learners are identified by their academic performance and achievements. Special guidance and consultations are given to the advanced learners to secure high percentage of marks in university examination. The faculty members of the departments and the placement cell constantly encourage the advanced learners to write pertinent competitive exams. Advanced learners are also motivated to enroll in certification courses, NPTEL and participate in intercollegiate competition, technical fests and state/national level seminar. Merit students are felicitated on Engineers day and Annual day with prizes and mementos to motivate them to continue their academic excellence. They are also challenged with research projects, mini projects and internships and due guidance and resources provided. Advanced learners are encouraged to take up skills-based training and skills training labs by domain experts.
- ❖ Slow learners are identified and ear marked based on their poor academic performance in the continuous internal assessment tests and classroom interactions. Mentors are deputed to enhance the performance of weak students by regular counseling and providing moral support to them and encouraging them towards study through peer tutoring. Faculty provides extra attention to them in subject lectures.
- ❖ Remedial classes are conducted by every department and extra classes are arranged for backlog subjects if needed. Slow learners are constantly monitored for their performance in internal tests. Also regular communication is maintained with parents for implementation of follow-up procedures at home and for regularity in attendance. Students who studied in a regional medium are provided free coaching to improve their written and spoken English skills. Online Classes are conducted to provide a second level of learning for all the students, in the required subjects. The teaching content is well supplemented with pertinent case studies for providing real world knowledge about the subject being taught.
