The CSI student chapter for the Department of IT@MRCET was inaugurated on 02/11/2019.

The CSI Student Chapter at MRCET for the departments of IT conducted one day seminar on DEVOPS 01/02/2020. It was graciously inaugurated by **Dr. V S K Reddy, Principal, MRCET** along with **Dr.G Sharada, Director, IT** and **Dr. N. S. Gowri Ganesh, HOD, IT**. The technical seminar presentation on DEVOPS was given by **Mr.Kamlesh Kumar,Associate VP** at JP Morgan, AWS Certificate Solution Architect, Bangalore.

Mr.Kamlesh Kumar,Associate VP at JP Morgan, AWS Certificate Solution Architect, Bangalore DevOps Engineer, certified devops Expert and delivered a talk on “Devops Technology”. DevOps is a set of practices that combines software development (Dev) and information-technology operations (Ops) which aims to shorten the systems development life cycle and provide continuous delivery with high software quality. In 2009, the first conference named devopsdays was held in Ghent, Belgium. The conference was founded by Belgian consultant, project manager and agile practitioner Patrick Debois.who? The conference has now spread to other countries. In 2012, the State of DevOps report was conceived and launched by Alanna Brown at Puppet. As of 2014, the annual State of DevOps report was published by Nicole Forsgren, Gene Kim, Jez Humble and others. In 2014, they found that DevOps adoption was accelerating. Also in 2014, Lisa Crispin and Janet Gregory wrote the book More Agile Testing, containing a chapter on testing and DevOps.

The speaker has given the sufficient information about the DevOPs and students also interacted with him for clarification on this topic on the recent trends.

The program was a grand success and paved way for many such endeavours in future.
